- 3. Eligible persons: Any foreign national (regardless of visa status)
- 4. Contents:
 - (1) General consultation on labor and employment matters. Examples: "is it possible to work with my current visa status at the company I have been offered a job (or for which I am about to apply)?", "I cannot find a job", "I quit my job, but I did not get unemployment insurance", "Salaries and overtime pay are not properly paid". "I am in trouble because I was laid off", "I was injured in an accident at work but was not adequately compensated". *Labor Dept. Officers will be available to answer queries.
 - (2) General legal advice: General legal advice other than labor advice is also available.
- 5. Interpreters of English, Chinese, Tagalog, Spanish, Portuguese, and Thai are scheduled to be provided. (Online interpretation provided by private interpreting companies may be available in languages other than those listed above.)
- 6. We encourage you to:
 - (1) bring your employment contract or pay-slips
 - (2) For those who will seek legal advice other than labor concerns, please bring any document that has something to do with your consultation.
